## PRELIMINARY RACE INSTRUCTIONS & ENTRY FORM

1. Races will be undertaken within rules dictated by the International Collision Regulations, Racing Rules of Sailing (2001 - 2004), the RYA prescriptions, The Hamble River By-Laws and any other class rules which apply and the race instructions on the day. Times will be taken from the visual signals; the failure of a sound signal shall be disregarded.
2. Starting procedure will be presented upon registration at the start venue.
3. There will be no race unless two boats compete.
4. All craft must keep clear of large vessels in the deep water channels.
5. Protests may be handed to the race committee within 1 hour of completing the race accompanied by a non-returnable fee of £10.00.
6. Competitors retiring please notify the committee by mail or phone (number will be advised prior to start)
7. Adequate personal buoyancy should be carried at all times when competing.
8. Everyone must have fun and enjoy themselves.
9. In particular Teams:
  - a. Shall accept full responsibility for the seaworthiness and safe navigation of the gigs and their crews and use their own judgement whether to start, continue, or retire from a race in the existing forecast conditions.
  - b. Shall draw attention of their crews to this disclaimer before the start of any race.
  - c. Shall hold adequate Third party Indemnity for the whole period of the Regatta.

**All race entrants must read the disclaimer and the information attached to every race entry form before completing their entry.**

The Committee is providing this regatta only on the understanding that they bear no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience to yachts or persons howsoever arising directly or indirectly from their rules, policy, or rulings during the racing.
